

TULIP BOUQUET CHARM

FREE PATTERN GUIDE | BEGINNER | CROCHET



Before you begin

This guide follows the maker's shared process for forming separate tulip heads, adding stems and leaves, and arranging the finished bouquet.

01

Finish the flower heads

Crochet the petals and buds separately. Keep the stitch count even, then join the pieces in order to form a full tulip silhouette.

02

Join stems and leaves

Fix a stem to the base of each bud. Add leaves at different heights so the bouquet keeps a natural rhythm and balanced direction.

03

Assemble and wrap

Arrange the flowers at varied heights and check the balance. Secure the stems, then finish with wrapping paper and a braided tie.

Finishing note

Shape each petal gently, keep the bouquet light, and adjust the leaf angles before securing the final wrap.
